CLASS PREVIEWS AND UPDATES

Classes with Mrs. Jansen

Religion - We will be discussing the story of Mary and Martha next week. Memory work is due on Thursday (Romans 10:9).

Math - Third graders will have a test on Monday over division. They will then skip to chapter 8 and learn about different measurements. Fourth graders will also be learning about measurements: inches, feet, yards, and miles.
